Desired Qualifications

- Training and experience with challenge course programs (must be documented); prefer some highly experienced
- Current CPR and First Aid certifications
- Ability to coordinate a challenge course program using a course designed for camp
- Ability to maintain course in excellent working condition
- College student or at least 19 years of age

Responsible to: Summer Administrator

General Responsibility

To plan, direct, and supervise camp's challenge course program

Specific Responsibilities

- 1. Set up challenge course prior to and during staff training.
- 2. Teach staff their responsibilities in activity area during staff training.
- 3. Teach and monitor proper use of equipment.
- 4. Conduct initial and end-of-season inventory, and store equipment for safety.
- 5. Check equipment daily and make (or request) repairs.
- 6. Review and update session outlines for age appropriate activities in order to ensure a progression of challenges for campers from year to year.
- 7. Check in with counselor prior to their group's session and design individual sessions based on the group's needs.
- 8. Follow standard rules applicable to challenge course, rappelling, etc.
- 9. Other duties as assigned by the Summer Administrator.

Essential Functions

- physical strength to spot and belay participants
- ability to train staff and campers in safety regulations and emergency procedures
- cognitive and communication abilities to plan and conduct the activity to achieve camper development objectives
- ability to maintain a safe and well-organized challenge course area at all times

Time Off

One period per day or after 8:00 PM until evening prayer. Specific time to be determined by the Challenge Course Director and the Summer Administrator.
